Attached for your consideration is an ordinance setting the tax levies for 2018 (fiscal year 2019). This ordinance sets tax levies as follows:

Adoption of this levy results in a \$0.0006 (0.005 percent) increase in the total City tax levy. This increase was driven by the fact that assessed values on new construction exceeded the growth in assessed values on real estate. Anytime that assessed values increase by a rate that exceeds the inflation rate used by the State Tax Commission, property tax rates decrease and anytime that assessed values decrease or increase at a rate lower that the inflation rate used by the State Tax Commission rates increase.
