**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING GENERAL AND SPECIAL TAXES ON THE CITY OF  
EXCELSIOR SPRINGS, MISSOURI FOR THE TAX YEAR 2021.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Excelsior Springs, Missouri, as follows:
